| Bassed both sections of the National Board Examination (NBE) OR is a licensed Funeral Director/Embalmer in their state

| Complete a minimum of 180 quarter credit hours or 120 semester credit hours towards graduation
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| Dept division core courses are required (44 quarter credit hours)
